

4-H - FFA Livestock Sale

Friday, August 11, 2017
6:00pm.

General Rules:

1. Each exhibitor may sell one (1) each of two species, Species include: Beef Steers, Dairy Steers, Market Hogs, Market Sheep, Market Goats, Rabbits or Poultry.
2. Commission fees will be deducted from sales checks according to the following rates but with \$5.00 minimum commission: 3% Beef and Dairy Steers, 4% Market Hogs, 5% Market Lambs, Market Goats, Rabbits and Poultry.
3. Eligible sales participants must pre-register for the sale on their respective species form, in the fair office, by Thursday, August 10, 2017 at 8 p.m. Eligible participants who do not pre-register will not be able to sell. Participants will receive written notice of the marketing and sale promotion responsibilities, sale night procedures and required attire.
4. All exhibitors must have bonafide ownership according to species guidelines.
5. All market animals must be weighed and tagged at their respective weigh in. Rabbits will be tattooed by Mid-July.
6. Show weight will be sale weight.
7. Exhibitors will be required to submit a copy of their buyers' thank you notes to the QA County Livestock committee at a date and time to be announced to receive their checks.
8. The 4-H show judge will determine if animals are adequately finished and suitable to sell. The judge's decision is final. The judge will report his or her decision to a sale committee representative and show chairman simultaneously.
9. In the event of death or sickness of an animal, a replacement may not be acquired after the ownership deadline for entry in the sale. Beef animals- judge will determine if animals are adequately finished and suitable to sell. Swine-market hogs must weigh a Minimum of 215 pounds and a maximum of 300 pounds. There will be a 5 pound tolerance. Individual meat birds, rabbits and pen of rabbits must meet the criteria as stated in the general rules for that species. Goats- goats must be a minimum of 40 Lbs. and a maximum of 110 Lbs. There will be a 5 Lb. Tolerance. Sheep must be a minimum 80 pounds. All sale animals—judge will determine if animals are adequately finished and suitable to sell. The judge's decision is final.
10. Animals purchased and donated back for resale will not be brought back into the ring. They will be sold at market price with proceeds being donated to a fund selected by the buyer.
11. All livestock exhibitors will be required to attend Quality Assurance Training-every other year-Session date will be announced in your clover press.
