### **Rules and Regulations: (English & Western)**

1. 4-H Exhibits are subject to all rules in the Maryland 4-H Horse and Pony Rule Book. The rule book may be downloaded at [www.4horse.umd.edu/documents/4H266layout08.pdf](http://www.4horse.umd.edu/documents/4H266layout08.pdf)
2. All Queen Anne's County 4-H Exhibitors must have a valid official Horse & Pony Card on file in the Extension office by 4:30 on June 1. ALL exhibitors must complete NEW cards on every project animal for 2017. Cards can be sent in the mail or hand delivered. No electronic versions will be accepted.

A Valid Copy of a Coggins test must accompany the 4-H Horse and Pony ID Card.

Out of county 4-H members should have a Horse and Pony cards on file in the Extension office of their respective county. Out of State 4-H exhibitors must provide documented proof from their extension office that the animal was a valid 4-H project by June 1, 2017.

3. All Pony and Horse Exhibits staying the week Must be on the grounds by 2:00pm. Monday, August 7, 2017. Pony and horse exhibits showing for the day must be on the grounds by 8:00am show day.  
NO ONE WILL BE ALLOWED TO TAKE ANIMAL STAYING FOR THE WEEK OFF THE GROUNDS BEFORE 10:00PM ON SATURDAY THE LAST DAY F FAIR, Unless authorized by the Equine Fair Chairman or Designee.

4. All Animals entering the Fair Grounds must have a current copy of a 'NEGATIVE' Coggins and an MDA Equine Self Certification form completed.

YOU WILL NOT BE PERMITTED ON THE FAIR GROUNDS IF YOU ARE MISSING EITHER FORM.

5. If you have a stall you must compete in herdsman.
6. One exhibitor per Animal, per age division
  - A. If you were a **4-H Exhibitor** and had a stall in 2016 you will be offered one in 2017, if you turned in your record book, and there were no infractions at the fair in previous years.
  - B. Vacant stalls will be filled using the following criteria;
    1. Number of years carrying the horse project.
    2. Record book turned in the previous year.
    3. Total number of years occupying a stall at the county fair.

4. Must attend at least 75% of your club meetings and scheduled activities for the year 2016.
5. Exhibitors Under the age of 8 will be offered a stall, if there are stalls available after all of the 4-H Exhibitors have been offered stalls.
6. If Exhibitor cannot stay over-night, he or she must see that the animal is taken care of.
7. Ponies and Horses shall be under control and a safe distance apart at all times, both in and out of the ring.
8. The exhibitor will be the only one allowed to work on his/her animal(s) during the entire fair week.
9. The Show Committee is consisted of the Equine Fair Chairman and/or the Equine Fair Chairman's designee.
10. The Committee will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to any rider, attendants, animals, equipment or spectators at the Show.
11. No person will be allowed in the Show Ring during the time of Judging, except the Exhibitor and those having duties to perform.
12. Classes may be substituted, combined or dropped at the discretion of the Show Judge, Chairman or Designee.
13. Unlimited classes between all show days
14. Rosettes will be given for placings 1-6 for each Class. High Point Champion and High Point Reserve Champion will be given for each Age Division.
15. Ties will be broken by having a ride-off judged in that particular division class.
16. Exhibitors who have stalls for the week should register for a minimum of 50% of the activities offered at the horse ring. You must sign up for these at the announcers stand or designated area assigned by the fair chairman.
